

General Rules for Sports Events

1. Team members are expected to go and return on a team bus. **Exceptions to this must be presented in writing to the coach for each game.**
- 2. Parents are expected to pick up their athlete promptly following practices and games.**
3. For all school-sponsored sporting events, athletes will be neatly and appropriately dressed.
4. Athletes are expected to care for their uniforms as directed by the coach. Any uniform lost or damaged will be replaced at the athlete's expense.
5. No student will be allowed to participate in any sport activity without appropriate clothing.
6. The coaches and advisors will let the students and parents know when practices and meetings will end. Students who stay for any activity must be picked up as soon as that activity is over. Please refer to your schedule or the monthly calendar.
7. Students who are not picked up on time may be suspended or dismissed from the activity or team at the discretion of the coach.
8. Students in grades K-4 may not be dropped at the school to watch an athletic event. Adults must accompany these children to events.
9. Non-athletes in grades 5-8 may attend school events without a parent. However, these students must behave responsibly and be picked up on time. If they do not comply with these restrictions, they will be barred from future events unless an adult accompanies them.

Reminder: The school does not provide supervision for students waiting for a practice or game. Please check with the school before leaving your child at the school for a practice or activity.
